The Need






- Small manufacturing and subsistence agricultural workers in Africa are in desperate need of basic tools to work safely and without inflicting wear and tear to the human body.
- These small yet vital employers lack funding to integrate the application of ergonomic principles into jobs which rely heavily on physical human labor.
- The field of ergonomics looks for ways to improve conditions so that the work can be done effectively and with less harm to the human body.
